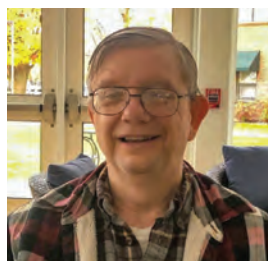

I like being here around such nice people. Everyone treats me nice, and there are so many fun things to do.

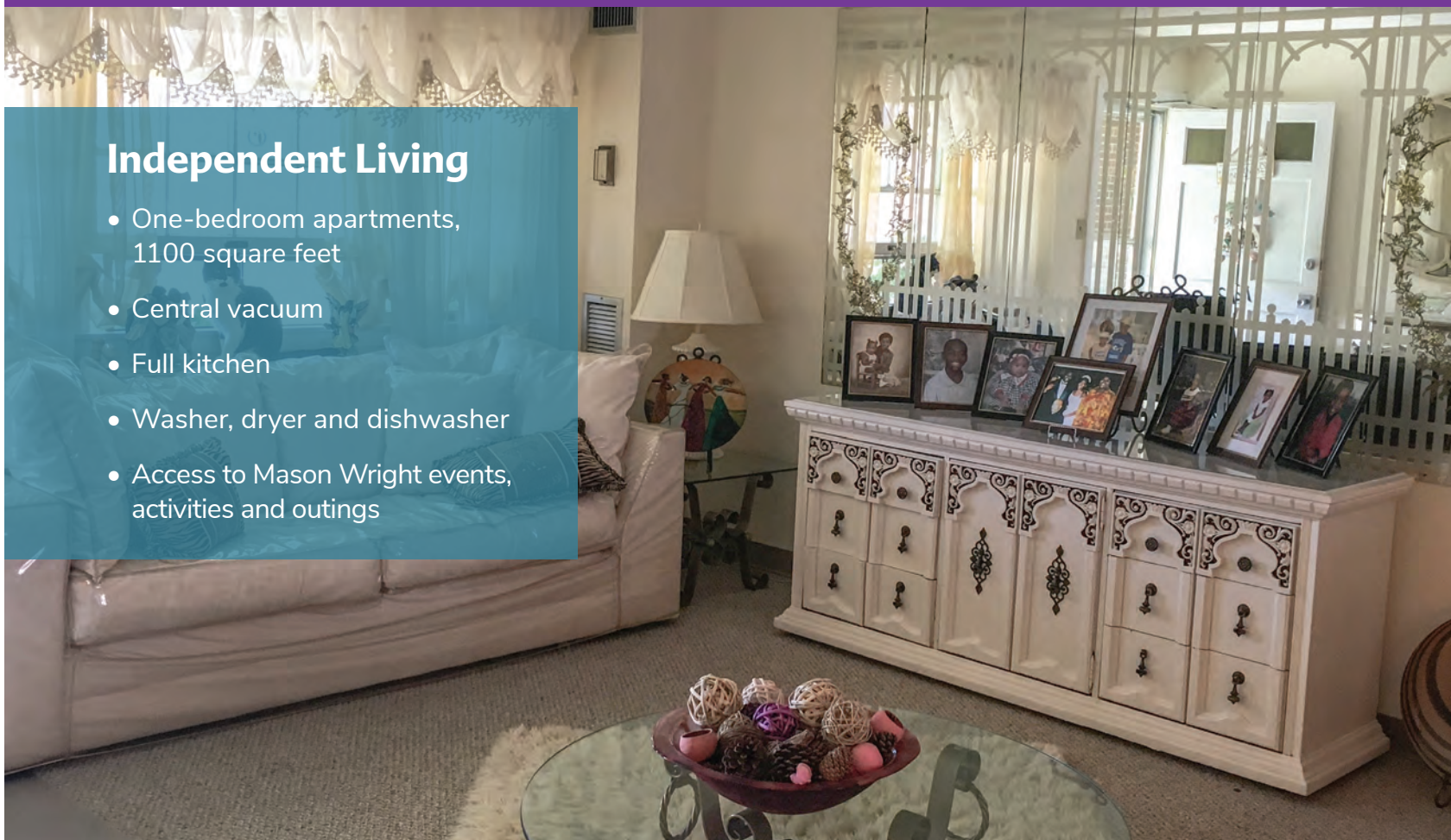
